

BUSSELTON JETTY SWIM 2010
RACE RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY
The following race rules remain subject to change

1. Competitors may enter for a solo 3.6km swim around the Jetty **OR** a 1km short course; the following conditions of entry apply to both swim courses.
2. Only competent swimmers who are fit and adequately trained should enter.
3. An official online entry must be completed by each swimmer. Completion of the online entry form and payment of the entry fee represents acceptance of the rules and conditions.
4. The following age categories apply for men and women: under 15; 15-19; 20-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75 and over. Age category is based on age at swim day.
5. Trophies are awarded as per the award list (see below).
6. Swimmers in the 1km short course will start 50m west of the finishing arch. They will swim out approximately 450m and on the return leg will gradually merge with the returning 3.6km swimmers. See course map.
7. The swim courses are marked with buoys; swimmers should use these as a guide.
8. Swimmers or support craft are not permitted to go under any part of the Jetty.
9. Wetsuits and/or swimming aids are permitted but wearers will not be eligible for awards.
10. Wetsuits and/or swimming aids must be declared on the entry form.
11. Swim caps indicating starting wave and event category will be supplied and must be worn.
12. Competitors will be required to have their race number displayed on their front left thigh with waterproof marker.
13. Swimmers will be given a timing band to be worn on the ankle.
14. Swimmers must complete the race by walking through the electronic timing gate on the beach.
15. Swimmers must proceed to the check-in desk upon finishing, state their race number and receive their finisher's medallion.
16. Swimmers withdrawing from the event must present themselves at the check-in desk and confirm their withdrawal.
17. Failure to return a timing band will result in a \$25 penalty payable to the check-in desk on the day.
18. Support paddlers are encouraged for safety but may not be used for coaching, directing or aiding forward progress.
19. Support paddlers must attend the support paddler's briefing and receive identification to be worn for the event.
20. All vessels in the vicinity of the event, whether involved in the event or not must abide by the Navigable Waters Regulations. Authorized officers will police these regulations as part of the overall safety provisions for the event.
21. A swimmer may be disqualified at the discretion of the race organisers for contravening the race rules or for unsporting conduct.
22. The organisers of the swim, Busselton Allsports Inc., reserve the right to accept or reject any application at their discretion and also to issue special invitations.
23. Entries close at midnight, Western Standard Time, Wednesday 3 February 2010.
24. Late entries are not accepted.
25. Replacement swimmers are not accepted.
26. Refunds are only available if applied for in writing or by email and must be applied for prior to the entry closing date of Wednesday 3 February 2010. A \$10 administration fee per swimmer will be retained.
27. The event organisers reserve the right to close entries early.
